

Batesville Memorial Public Library Mobile Hotspot Policy

Guidelines for Borrowing & Use Outside of the Library

- Patrons must be 21 years of age or older to checkout a Mobile HotSpot.
- A valid Batesville Memorial Public Library account AND a current driver’s license, passport or military ID must be present at the time of checkout.
- Patron must reside in the Batesville Memorial Public Library district.
- Patron must be in good standing with the library, with a current address on file and no current fines.
- **Mobile Hotspots may only be checked out from and returned to the circulation desk. A Mobile HotSpot cannot be returned in the drop boxes or to another library.**
- Mobile HotSpots may be checked out for one week with no renewals.
- Overdue Mobile HotSpots will be **deactivated** within 24 hours of due date.
- The Mobile HotSpot can provide Wi-Fi Internet access for up to 10 devices.
- The Mobile HotSpot should be kept in a temperature controlled environment; **Do Not leave it in your car.**
- **NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS:** Internet content filtering is NOT provided through the BMPL Mobile HotSpot. Parents/Guardians are responsible for monitoring what their children access via the BMPL Mobile HotSpot.

Fines & Liability

- The overdue fine is \$5 per day until returned
- Patrons will be charged \$25 for Mobile HotSpots returned to a book drop (indoor or outdoor) or to another library.
- The patron is responsible for costs associated with the loss or damage of the Mobile HotSpot and/or accessories.

Replacement Costs

- Mobile HotSpot unit: \$75
- Power adaptor: \$10
- Power cord: \$10
- Case: \$15
- Total Replacement: \$110
